

Morning News Summary

US Stocks Mixed

US stocks were mixed overnight as gains from companies such as DuPont and Lexmark International due to better than expected earnings were outweighed by retreats in the retail sector following a fall in consumer confidence, which is down to a five month low.

DuPont, the third biggest chemical maker in the US, surged +3.2%, while printer maker Lexmark, climbed +9.1% on a positive earnings report. Banks advanced overnight, with Bank of America and Citigroup up at least +1.0%, while retailers such as Amazon and Lowe's retreated over -2.4%, leading the sector to the biggest decline among the 24 groups in the S&P 500 Index.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up +0.1% at last check, while the Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down -0.1%, after retailers had pared gains of as much as +0.5% early in the day.

European Shares Continue Gains

Stocks in the UK gained for the second straight day, led by a surge from banks, after the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision relaxed some of its proposed capital and liquidity rules. Barclays and Lloyds Banking Group advanced over +7.0% each, while AstraZeneca climbed +2.0% after US regulators announced they may clear the drugmaker's blood-thinner Brilinta. Oil company Tullow Oil, advanced +2.7% following the sale of Heritage Oil & Gas's Ugandan assets. The FTSE 100 Index rose +0.3%.

European stocks made it six days straight, advancing as banks UBS and Deutsche Bank reported earnings that beat market estimates and the Basel Committee relaxed proposed capital rules. UBS surged the most in 15 months, while Deutsche climbed +4.5%. Tomkins soared +5.4% after agreeing to be bought by the Canada Pension Plan Investment Board and Onex Corp. The Stoxx 600 gained +0.4%, only +5.2% from this year's high on April 15.

Asian Stocks Advance, Nikkei Flat.

The MSCI Asia Pacific rose for a third straight day on positive US home sales data and earnings reports which boosted investor confidence. James Hardie Industries, the biggest seller of home cladding in the US, jumped +2.9%, while Sumitomo Mitsui Financial Group rose +2.8% on higher earnings at its investment bank unit, while HSBC Holdings gained +1.4% after UBS reported a third quarterly profit.

The Nikkei 225 slid overnight even as most Japanese stocks gained, with Tokyo Airlines up +1.4% and Seiko Epson climbing +4.4%. Japan's second largest steel maker JFE Holdings declined -3.1% after a negative earnings report.

ASX Advances

The ASX 200 advanced +0.3% yesterday as gains were pared by gold producers such as Newcrest Mining (-0.9%). Gains were led by James Hardie Industries (+2.9%) and Wesfarmers (+0.9%) following an analyst upgrade.

Gold, Crude Fall

Gold fell -1.9% to \$1,160.75, while crude declined -2.1% to \$77.34.

NZ Headlines

Abano Healthcare Group announced a tax-paid profit of \$4.4m from continuing operations for the year to May 31, in line with expectations. In addition there was a one off gain of \$77.1m from the sale of Bay Audiology in November 2009 and a \$4.5m impairment charge in relation to the Rehabilitation business.

Genesis Energy has applied for resource consent for a development at Castle Hill, where a windfarm would be spread over 30,000 hectares of land 20km northeast of Masterton in the south and 20km east of Eketahuna in the north.

The New Zealand Superannuation Fund posted its second monthly negative return in a row of -1.54% last month, compared with -4.82% in May.

Tourism Holdings has announced that it expects its annual net profit to decline by \$940,000 as a result of government tax changes to depreciation announced in the budget.
