

# Morning News Summary

## US Stocks Flat

US stocks were flat for the second straight day, as earnings and forecasts that disappointed investors at technology and consumer staples companies wiped out an early advance.

Akamai Technologies declined -11.0% after announcing its profit margin declined, while Nvidia and Symantec both lost over -9.1% after issuing disappointing forecasts. Colgate Palmolive retreated -6.8%, sending markets further into the red until a late rally from Goldman Sachs and Microsoft saw declines pared.

The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down -0.1% at last check, having reversed early gains of up to +0.9%, while the Dow Jones Industrial Average was sitting just in the red, down -0.1% as well.

## European Shares Fall, FTSE Flat

Stocks in the UK were relatively flat overnight, as Unilever led a decline among consumer goods shares, offsetting a rally from AstroZeneca, which surged to its highest level since 2006 after winning a US panels backing to sell its experimental blood thinner Bilinta. Unilever declined -2.4% after US rival Colgate Palmolive sales missed analysts' estimates, while Kellogg said that its recall of over 28 million boxes of cereal last month will lower its earnings this year. The FTSE 100 Index fell -0.1%.

European stocks fell for a second straight day following declines from food and basic resource shares, and as concern mounted that tomorrow's US gross domestic product report may show growth slowed in the world's largest economy. Nestle and Unilever slid over -1.5% each, while Vallourec dropped -3.1% after announcing a recovery in the steel industry will slow. Telephonica pared losses, gaining +3.0% on increased earnings, seeing the Stoxx Europe 600 Index slide -0.4%.

## Asian Stocks Flat, Nikkei Down.

The MSCI Asia Pacific was flat overnight as the yen gained on concern the pace of the global recovery may slow. 550 stocks declined to 360 that gained, with Samsung Electronics falling -1.2% and Panasonic down -7.7% on speculation the company will sell stock to buy out two units. Gains from HTC (+6.9%) and Nippon Yusen K.K. (+5.0%) pared losses.

The Nikkei 225 Stock Average declined, with the Topix Index down for the first day in five. Inpex sank -3.0% while electronics companies led markets down.

## ASX Falls

The ASX 200 declined -0.1% yesterday, as recent falling oil prices felled Woodside Petroleum and Santos, both declining over -1.0%.

## Gold, Crude Gain

Gold gained +0.4% to \$1,168.03, while crude rallied +1.8% to \$78.36.

## NZ Headlines

Auckland International Airport has announced that Jetstar is to expand its trans-Tasman services with a new daily Jetstar Auckland-Melbourne service begins in December, and a three times a week service to Cairns commences next April. Jetstar are also set to increase its domestic services to 84 weekly return flights by the year's end.

New Zealand Oil & Gas has announced operating revenue for the quarter of \$31.3m, of which \$13.1m was from the sale of Tui oil and \$18.2m from the sale of Kupe sales gas, LPG and light oil.

The Reserve Bank of New Zealand raised the Official Cash Rate 25bp, to 3.0%, and Alan Bollard said subdued domestic demand and a fragile global recovery meant further increases to the OCR would probably be less aggressive than was anticipated in the June 10 Monetary Policy Statement.

At its AGM, Ryman Healthcare, which has 21 villages with 4,400 units or rooms in New Zealand, announced it is looking for a suitable site for its first Australian village.

Telecom has announced the sale of its stake in Macquarie Telecom for A\$9.9m.

Statistics New Zealand has reported that New Zealand recorded a trade surplus of \$276m for the month of June, equivalent to 7.3% of exports. The largest increases in exports last month, compared to June 2009, were in milk powder, butter, cheese, and logs, wood and wood articles.
