What is the purpose of this update?

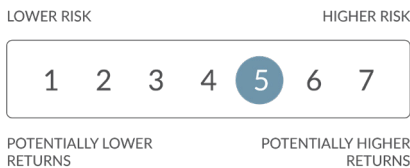
Description of this fund

The Global Growth Fund aims to achieve positive long term returns by investing in an underlying fund (or funds) which invest in companies that demonstrate a competitive advantage, achieve excess returns and reinvest these returns into business growth.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator¹ for Global Growth Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund’s assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

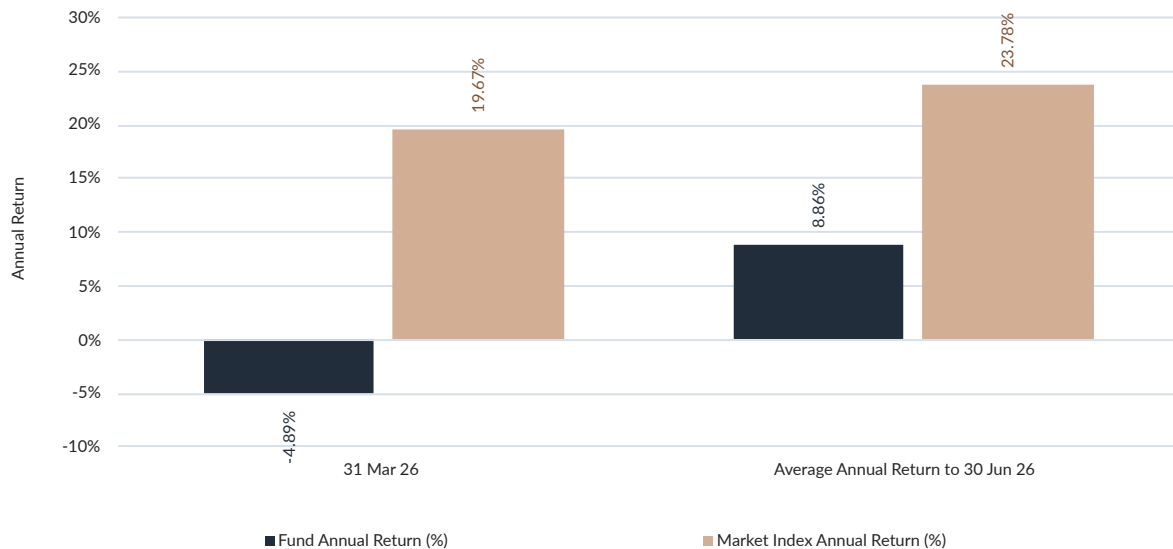

Investors may also be charged individual action fees for specific actions or decisions (for example for withdrawing from or switching funds). EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Phoebe had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Phoebe received a return after fund charges were deducted but before tax of \$112 (that is 1.12% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Phoebe a total return after tax of \$20 for the year.

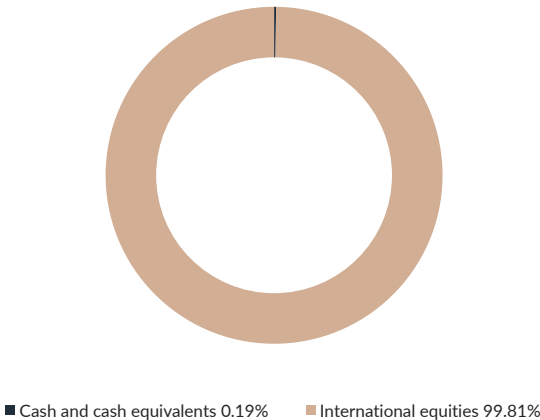

Notes

1. This fund was launched on 15 May 2024. We first calculate the risk indicator using market index returns data for periods before that date, and actual fund returns data afterwards. However, using market index returns means that the risk indicator may provide a less reliable indicator of potential future volatility. So, if a fund mainly invests into another fund with a different risk indicator, we may adopt that number if we consider it is a more reliable indicator of the potential future volatility of the fund.
2. The estimated fund charges for the next scheme year are expected to increase from 1.38% up to 1.64% due to an upcoming change in the underlying fund in which the Global Growth Fund invests. These charges are inclusive of GST if applicable.
3. These charges include the management fees of underlying funds where we are not the manager. In order to estimate these charges, we take into account the proportion of the Forsyth Barr Fund that is invested in the underlying fund. We also consider the public disclosures for the underlying fund about its management and administration charges. We have assumed that these will not change (unless we change the underlying fund). We review all these estimates on an annual basis.
4. We have a new addition to key personnel, Jamie Young, who has not been named in a previous fund update for this fund. We have also updated some of the other position descriptions for key personnel to record that they are members of the Investment Committee for the relevant fund.
