Forsyth Barr Commentary

WIN jumped up from Beginner to Explorer this year, making good gains in the early stages of its C&ESG journey. It was particularly good to see WIN meaningfully improved across all four categories in the framework. WIN has started to disclose GHG emissions, which supported an improved 'C' score and should improve its overall rating over time, particularly if the trend shows a reduction in overall emissions. WIN's strongest category continues to be Social, supported by strong product quality & accessibility, diversity and stakeholder relations scores. There is still plenty of room for improvement but we are encouraged by WIN's progress to date.
